The City of Avon Lake has been working with county and state health officials regarding the COVID19 (Coronavirus). The Governor of Ohio has mandated social distancing and closures during this difficult time. Until the Governor of Ohio releases new directives reducing mandates and after careful consideration and for the safety of our residents, the following precautionary measures are being taken:

Update 5/15/20

• Yesterday, 5/14/20, Governor DeWine outlined reopening up pools and noncontact sport activities in the state of Ohio. The City of Avon Lake is waiting for the guidelines to be released from the state for reopening pools and noncontact sport programs so we can review the necessary safety, capacity and social distancing protocols required in order operate the facilities and programs. Once we have had a chance to thoroughly review, the administration will then make decision if/when the pool and fields will open. We anticipate having this information next week.

The City of Avon Lake will continually monitor the most current updates and information on the Coronavirus which is provided by the Centers for Disease Control and the Board of Health which could result in change to the currently tentative re-open date of our facilities, programs and activities.

Our goal by taking this course of action is to limit the opportunity for exposure as well as maintaining a safe, healthy place for our participants, residents and staff.
